

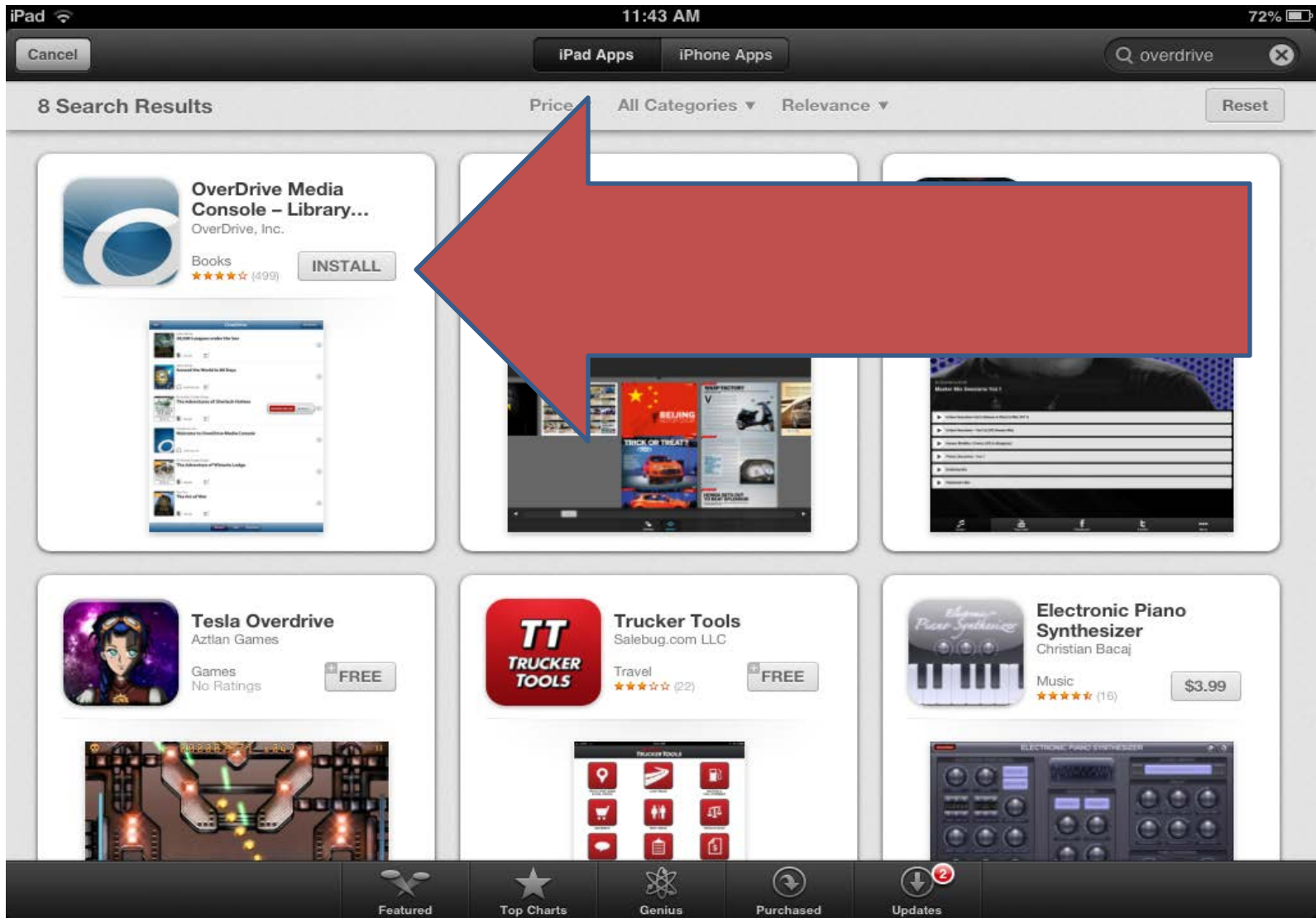


Downloading eBooks to your

OverDrive

Step 1: Go to your App Store



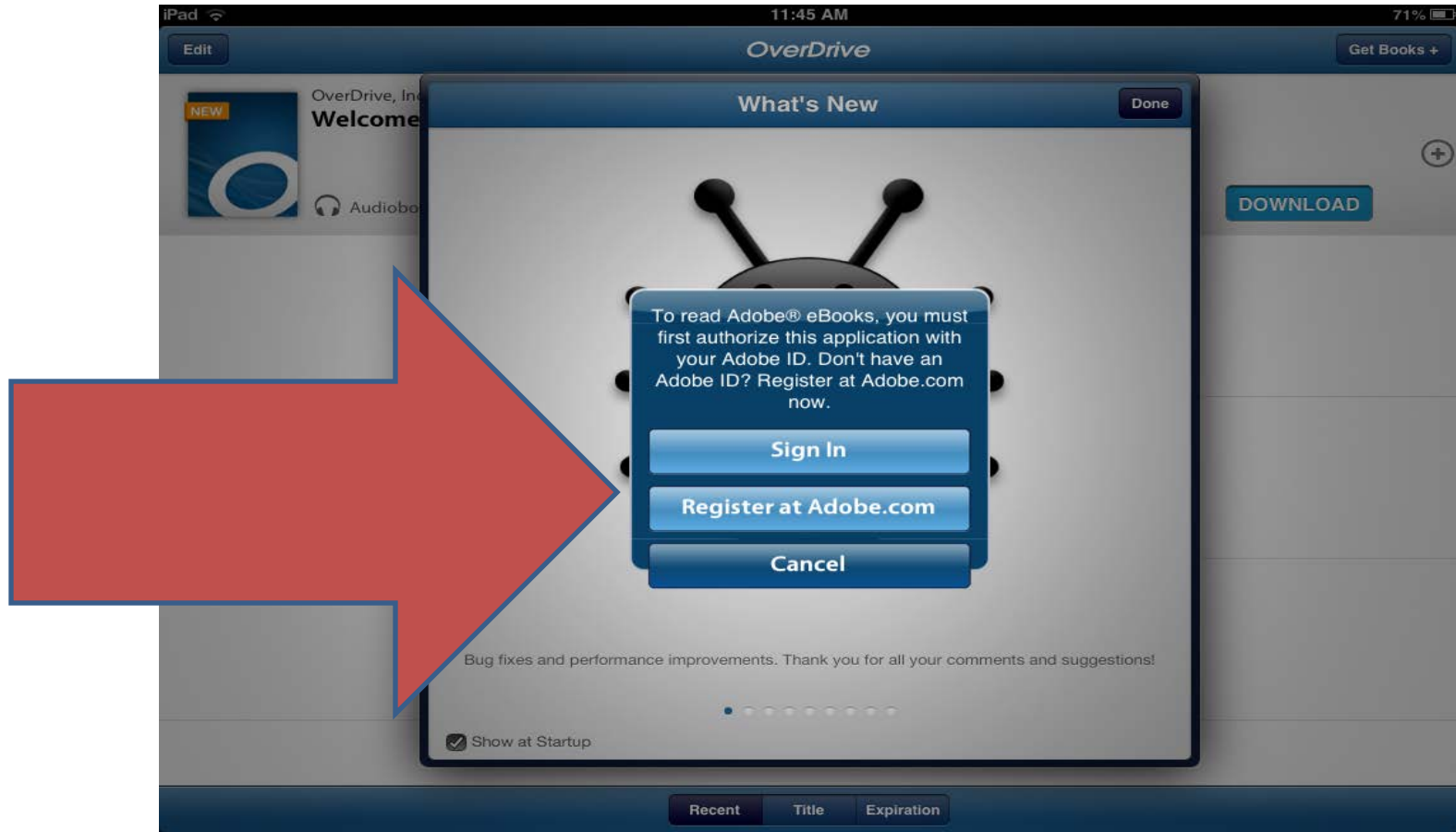
Step 2: Search for Overdrive in your App Store and tap on “Install” button



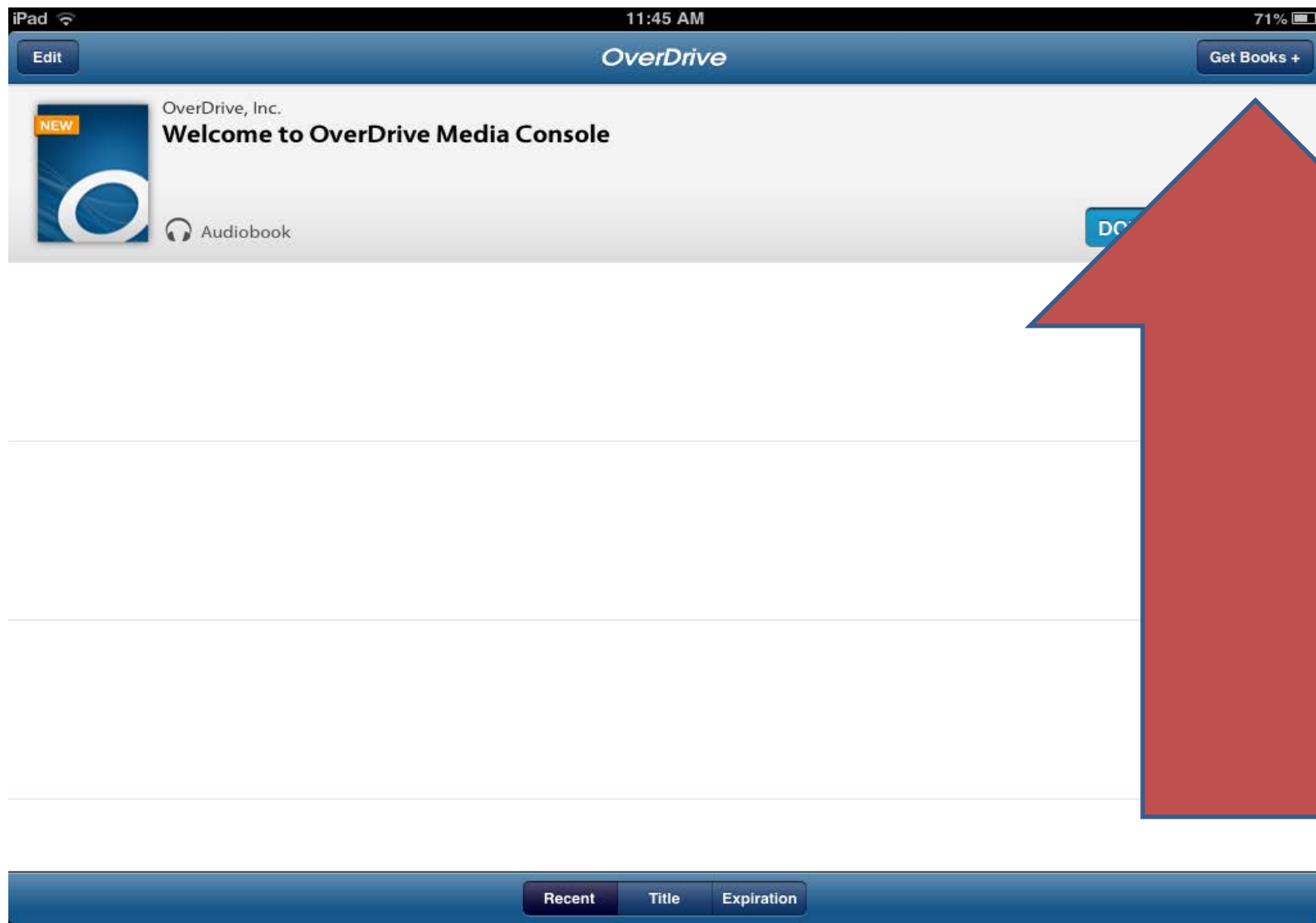
Step 3: Overdrive Media Console will now appear with your other apps



Step 4: Open Overdrive by tapping on the app. If you don't have an Adobe Digital Editions account, register for one now.



Step 5: After you have registered with Adobe, tap on “Get Books” Button



Step 6: Tap on “Add a Library” and enter information for Cedar Rapids Public Library



Step 7: Once you Find Cedar Rapids Public Library, tap on the star below to save your location. Then tap on the small arrow to browse the collection

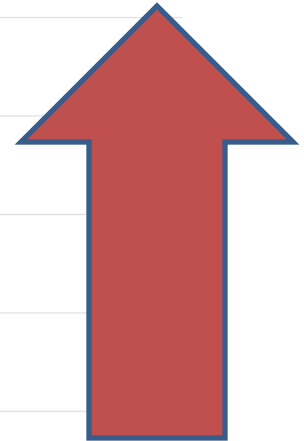
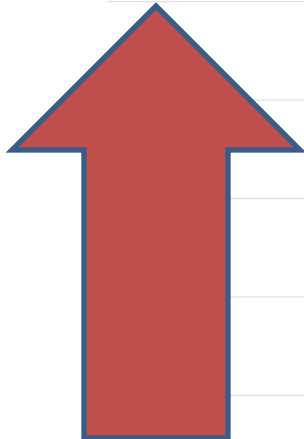

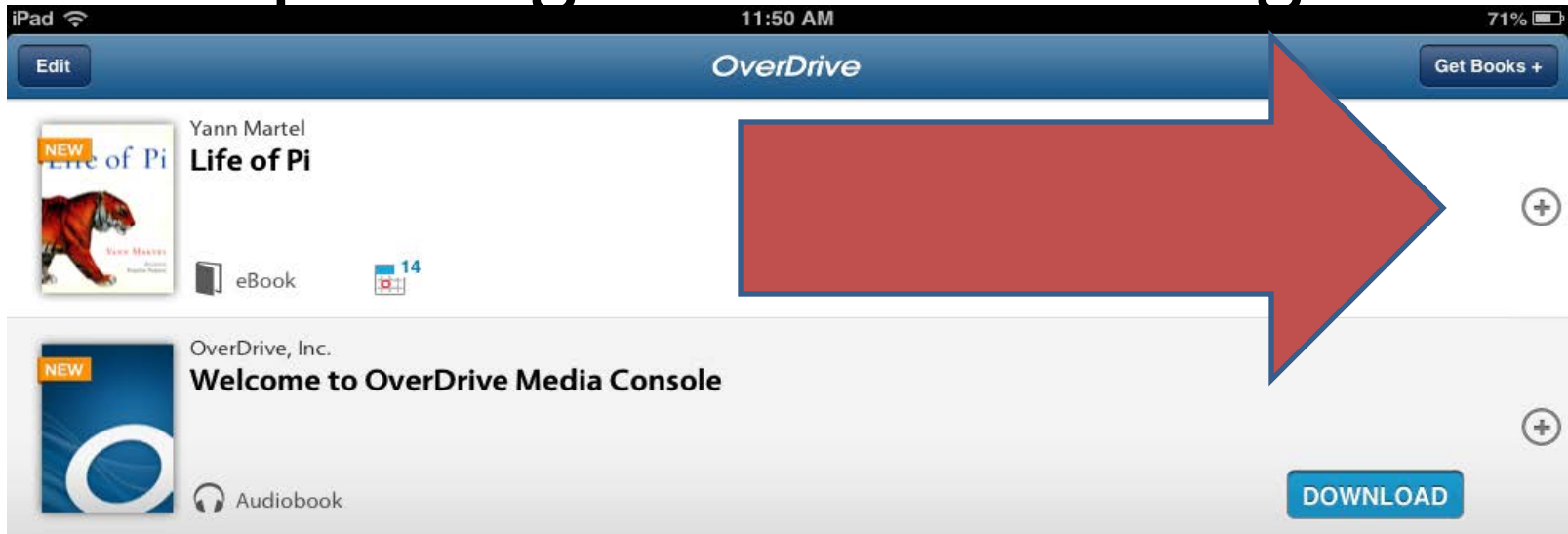
Step 9: You will need to enter your Library Card number and Pin. Choose the EPUB Format.
